## Total Eclipse of the Sun!

Plan to join us on April 8th when we will be experiencing a total solar eclipse! It will move across the United States beginning in Texas and ending in Maine. The totality of the eclipse can last from 2.5 minutes to just over 4 minutes. In West Michigan, a 94% partial eclipse will be seen. This means that the sky will not go completely dark. A crescent shape sun will be seen during the duration.

SUNGLASSES. I will make them available to you if you wish to join us on the patio to observe this event. It will take place around 3:11 p.m. The next total solar eclipse in Michigan will not be until 2099.
